The Board met in session at the Linn County Jean Oxley Public Service Center.

FARM TO MARKET REVIEW BOARD APPLICATION

WHEREAS, a county may apply for modifications to its farm to market system to add or subtract mileage from its system, to accept or delete highways gained or lost through jurisdictional transfers, or to change the classification of roads within its system. WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Linn County has consulted with its County Engineer and desires to modify its farm to market road system to provide continuity of intra-county and inter-county routes, to meet the needs of existing or potential traffic, to better meet land use needs, or to provide a more suitable location for a farm to market route, and

WHEREAS, application for modifications to any county's farm to market system must be made to the Farm to Market Review Board per the requirements of Code of Iowa Section 306.6.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF LINN COUNTY that this county is formally requesting that the Farm to Market Review Board approve the following modifications to its farm to market system:

Road segments proposed for addition to the farm to market system: Ellison Road from Highway 1 to the Jones County line. Pramod Dwivedi and Tricia Kitzmann, Public Health, gave the following update on Linn County's response to COVID-19:

- Vaccine supplies are on the front and center of their minds. Asking everyone to be patient. Expect 3,000 doses each week until the end of February.
- Linn County Public Health is planning to hold a vaccination clinic.
- 6,400 doses were split between Walgreens and CVS for 65 and older.
- If you choose to be vaccinated outside Linn County for first dose, the second dose will be harder to receive if choosing to be vaccinated in Linn County.
- Linn County cases are trending downward.
- Linn County has had 18,970 cases, 20 are hospitalized, 1,953 active cases and 312 deaths.

Sara Bearrows, Budget Dir., presented the Fiscal Year 2022 SF 634 Notice of Public Hearing - Proposed Property Tax Levy on total maximum property tax dollars.

Motion by Rogers, seconded by Zumbach set the public hearing to be on March 3, 2021 at 11:00 regarding proposed property tax levy.

Board Member Reports - Supervisor Zumbach toured the new LIFTS shop and the Juvenile Detention Center. Stopped at the Solid Waste Agency on the way home and attending a Lower Cedar Watershed zoom meeting last night.

Supervisor Rogers reported that he and Supervisor Zumbach participated in the Cedar Rapids and Linn County Conference Board meetings met with communications staff and Erin Foster re: Mental Health Access Center open house plans; Friday was the weekly COVID call as well as the weekly ASAC call; participated in the Local Homeless Coordinating board meeting; the Point in Time count of the homeless (done twice a year) was completed and verified the need for an overflow winter shelter; will be meeting with city and county staff re: long term vision and plans for the Fillmore Bldg. as an overflow shelter. Yesterday was the LCCS Comm. Services Board meeting.

Supervisor Rogers will forward several emails to the Auditor's Office objecting to the county's mask mandate.
