How does it work?

The vaccine teaches our body how to find & fight the virus that causes COVID-19.

You may have side effects after getting the vaccine. This is normal, temporary, and a sign your body is building immunity.



Who can get it?

People 12 years & older should get the vaccine when it is available to them.

People with medical conditions, who have had COVID-19, and those of different ages, races, and ethnicities. The vaccine is safe for people who are pregnant and those with weak immune systems, but should talk to their health care provider before getting the vaccine.

Your doctor is not allowed to share information with immigration officials.

You should not be asked about your immigration status when you get a COVID-19 vaccine.

A form of identification may be needed. Identification from your country of origin is accepted.
